4-1. SCUSD Board Meeting Summary —Pinkston

May 9th SCUSD Board Meeting:

Some items discussed:

Asian American Recognition month.

Gave the 3rd interim budget update. We'll discuss the budget at our next CPC meeting.

Proposed a plan for universal pre-K-3rd grade. Pre-Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten would work together. They will phase it in over three years. It would involve full-day learning programs.

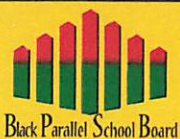
